

'STAR TREK - TIMELINES'

TEASER

EXT. FISHING BOAT

Barkley and Banner lay flat on the deck, looking up at the heavens. A great, growing din of WATER RUSHING interrupts the sloshes of the swells.

Banner holds a big joint with one hand while struggling with a big halibut across his chest with the other.

BARKLEY

I need some'a that.

BANNER

(passes him the fatty)
Don't suck it all out...
(lower)
... like the government.

BARKLEY

(takes a drag, alerts)
Do you hear that?

BANNER

What? I can't hear you over all
that racket!

BOTH

(pragmatic)
Ah, shit.

POV

The sky is suddenly blocked by a black saucer with a huge Jolly Roger staring down at them, whizzing past.

BOTH (CONT'D)

Pirates!

They're suddenly jerked upward as bottom of the hull begins swishing past only feet away, dominating their view, then the swell brings them dangerously closer and

WHAM!

The boat cabin strikes the hull, splintering the structure into toothpicks and rolling the boat over and over again like a log, both hulls crashing together several times with CRUNCHING BLOWS.

The boat, still, miraculously in one piece, slips through to the other side of the wave, upright, but semi swamped and in complete shambles, missing the cabin, but still with the poles resting in their holders.

As the sun strikes the boat, the, still, frothy seas calm and what's left of the vessel floats dead in the water.

The two men sit upright out of the swamped mess, dizzy and disoriented.

The WILD SQUEALING of the unraveling of fishing reels goes on without notice.

Both boys dart the eyes back and forth in a dizzy attempt to stabilize their view.

BANNER

Can't focus! I must be really high!

BARKLEY

Were those really pirates?

BANNER

(feeling and looking for the lunch box)
They had to be! They got the fish and our stash!

BARKLEY

Fuck! I didn't even see 'em!

BANNER

Never under estimate the government's greed!

BARKLEY

Oh, shut up.

BANNER

(happy)
Least we still got our --

The SCREAMING fishing poles are suddenly yanked away in a flash and a THUMP.

BOTH

(disheartened)
Ah!

EXT. ENTERPRISE

Slams back down onto the water and blazes past with a man hanging off the back of a nacelle and

TWO FISHING POLES

bouncing along in the water behind.

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Courtney sits in the captain's chair, eyes shut tight.

COURTNEY

Can't look!

No answer.

COURTNEY (CONT'D)

Ted? You there?

EXT. BACK OF NACELLE

Nobody to be found. The frame moves quickly backward on the nacelle, slows, follows the curved end down, finding

TED

Hanging by one hand from a ladder rung just short of taking a thirteen hundred foot dive into the ocean.

TED

(distracted, swinging)

I'm working on a project! Why aren't we in the air.

COURTNEY

I think the virus adapted. Not sure. I was sure you weren't over the side.

TED

(holds up the box with his free hand)

Who, me? Naw. Just hanging around, waiting for this radiation thingy to fill up.

He diverts his attention to the rear where he views

THE FISHING BOAT

From far off, bashed to pieces, but afloat.

TED (V.O.)
Looks like our fishing dudes made
it!

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Courtney takes a breath and checks the scanner, flinches.

COURTNEY
Still got two life signs. How'd
you know they made it?

TED
(struggling to climb)
I got faith in your work.

EXT. END OF NACELLE

Ted gazes out to the ocean.

TED (CONT'D)
... and a great vantage point.

COURTNEY (V.O.)
You're not just dangling off the
back or anything are ya? Mom used
to tell me how you'd get yourself
into a lot of really stupid --

TED
Don't listen to her. Her glass is
always half empty.

COURTNEY

Scrutinizes.

COURTNEY
How close are you to getting back?

TED (V.O.)
Well...

TED

Pulls himself up, resting the box on the upper rung and hooks
a foot on another piece of metal making his situation even
more precarious.

TED
It's taking a little longer than I
thought.

COURTNEY (V.O.)
You might wanna hurry. We got
another little dilemma.

EXT. BEARING STRAIGHT

A fishing boat floats along when it's turned to burning rubble by a phaser blast.

The shadow of the Klingon warbird whisks past the shattered, burning wreckage.

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Courtney stares into the scanner.

COURTNEY
The scanner tells me it's picked up
disruptor fire in the straight,
seventy miles west of Nome.

TED

Now nearly upside down, agonizes.

END TEASER

ACT I

EXT. ENTERPRISE NACELLE

Ted hangs upside down, off a rung.

TED
Are you sure?

COURTNEY (V.O.)
That's what the scanner thingy
says.

TED
(draws himself up)
Computer, on screen direction of
the phaser fire, full
magnification.

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Courtney's wide eyes are drawn to the

SCREEN

Where the Klingons skirt low on the water, leaving the
burning wreckage behind, turning for the Enterprise.

COURTNEY

Squints in denial.

TED

rights himself and starts the shaky climb up a series of
handles, pushing the box to the next rung.

TED
What do you see?

The box slips off. He catches it.

COURTNEY

Dazzled and concerned.

COURTNEY
You gotta be kidding!

TED
Now what!

COURTNEY

There's some big, green bird ship
heading sorta this way --

TED

Courtney! Take us down!

COURTNEY

What? Aren't you still out there?!

TED

Struggles to climb the rungs.

TED

Doesn't matter. I can take care of
myself! Battle stations!

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

The Doctor agonizes as Courtney sits in the chair.

THE DOCTOR

Battle with what? Slingshots and
rubber bands?

COURTNEY

I hate rubber bands!

TED (V.O.)

Ya need to take us down.

COURTNEY

We just got up.

TED

The water will deflect their
scanners.

COURTNEY

These aren't, Klingons?

TED

Yes.

COURTNEY

Oh, shit. Star Trek's...

TED

Real. Unfortunately, the bad guys
are too, now get us down.

COURTNEY

But how will you --

TED
I'll make it!

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Courtney watches a scanner.

COURTNEY
How tall is this ship?

THE DOCTOR
Six hundred forty point six meters.

COURTNEY
What?

THE DOCTOR
Twenty one hundred six point seven
feet --

COURTNEY
I can convert. It's only three
hundred feet deep here.

TED

Cringes and pounds his head on the surface.

TED
We gotta do something drastic!

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Courtney is agape.

COURTNEY
Two thousand feet, geez!

TED
Courtney!

COURTNEY
How are we supposed to --

TED
Don't start diving yet!

TED

Looks down at the starboard

HULL

As it knifes through the water below.

TED

Takes another labored grab onto a handle.

COURTNEY (V.O.)
Try hiding the Empire State
building, only worse!

TED
I'm kind'a aware of that. I'm
working on a plan!

He increases his efforts to climb.

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Courtney cringes, continues to hammer on the iPod.

COURTNEY
I've got my own. I'm trying
another reroute and adding a
firewall.

TED
Don't know what you just said but
it sounds good.

COURTNEY
Are you sure you're gonna get back?

TED (V.O.)
Promise.

COURTNEY
How are we gonna make it deeper
without cutting a channel?

TED (V.O.)
That's it! Now I got a plan!

TED

Makes headway near the top.

TED
Computer, what would it take to use
phasers to cut a channel deep
enough to submerge the ship?

COMPUTER
Phasers are off line and would
deflect off the surface of the
water.

TED
Photon torpedoes?

COMPUTER
At present speed, it would take
three maximum yield torpedoes at
four hundred forty seven meter
intervals at a distance of ten
point seven kilometers.

TED
Make it so! Fire!

THE ENTERPRISE

fires three torpedoes, striking the ocean far ahead.

The resulting underwater explosions blast muddy sea water
high into the sky.

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Courtney sits at the helm, jittery.

TED (V.O.)
Courtney, now.

Computer, take us down!

COMPUTER
Automated control function of
navigation is offline. Manual
navigation is required.

COURTNEY
I can't steer this thing!

TED

At the bomb, detaching the box and checking the

TIMER

At nineteen minutes.

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

The Doctor and Courtney nervously study the navigation
console.

TED (V.O.)

It's easy. Just be go the right speed and don't run us into the mud. We still got this bomb on board to --

COURTNEY

Thanks for the pep talk, Ted!

TED (V.O.)

Now that sounds like your mother.

COURTNEY

I could never take tests! That's why I only got a three point two.

TED (V.O.)

I suck at tests, too! Think of it as a video game. You like those.

COURTNEY

I hate video games! I always die!

TED (V.O.)

Forget it then!

TED

At the top, jerks the box off the bomb and bursts into a dead run toward the front of the Nacelle.

TED

I should'a just let go!

COURTNEY

Ted, what do I do?

TED

Reduce speed and dive with a three degree plane! Computer, increase shields to the main deflector in an elliptical pattern.

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Courtney pushes a slider and hits the

AFT ANTI GRAVITY THRUSTER

Button in short spurts.

ENTERPRISE

Thrusters on the back fire in short bursts.

COURTNEY

Shuts her eyes, tight, nervous.

COURTNEY
(on her Ipod)
Reducing speed.

Her eyes blow open and dart to the

FRONT SCREEN

Where a targeted position shows the newly cut channel's position. Crosshairs target the center of the channel.

COURTNEY

Squeezes out a wry smile.

COURTNEY (CONT'D)
I can do video games. I hate video games. We're gonna die.

TED

COURTNEY (V.O.)
I hate friggin' video games!

Dashes madly toward the small hatch at the front of the nacelle as

ENTERPRISE

knives through the water creating a great, inundating spray toward the back. The ship drops lower, lower

UNDER WATER

The bottom of the hull swooshes past, toward a massive, muddy channel blasted into the bottom.

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Courtney frets as she monitors a screen.

COURTNEY
Ted, are you in the ship yet?

TED (V.O.)
I'm a little busy right now.

TED

Still rushing forward as water begins blasting from beneath the saucer, obliterating the area overhead and behind him with spray. He's beaten by wind and water in every direction.

TED
(out of breath)
I gotta stop doing this crap!

INT. KLINGON BRIDGE

The Klingon helmsman alerts.

KLINGON HELMSMAN
We have charted a heading for the vessel.

BARAK SUL
Can we identify?

KLINGON HELMSMAN
It looks to be some kind of sea going ship.

BARAK SUL
Scanners!

KLINGON HELMSMAN
The drones are working on them. We can search of life signs and large objects at short range.

BARAK SUL
Ah! There is nothing on this backward planet that can defeat us! They are no threat, but not having working scanners is!

KLINGON HELMSMAN
They will not be --

BARAK SUL
Now!

Klingon Helmsman works.

KLINGON HELMSMAN
Two life signs.

BARAK SUL
Why do we bother?

KLINGON 3

We should send a landing party.

BARAK SUL

Our priority is to kill Kirk!

KLINGON HELMSMAN

Captain. One of the life signs is,
Captain Bundy.

BARAK SUL

(grits teeth)

Are you sure?

KLINGON HELMSMAN

I cannot be sure with this
equipment!

KLINGON 3

Killing them both will be a
glorious victory!

BARAK SUL

Battle stations! Today is a good
day for them to die.

EXT. ENTERPRISE NACELLE - DAY

Ted dashes, slipping and panting, still far from the hatch.
Water leaps over the front of the nacelle as it strikes the
surf soaking his path.

TED

Wrong damn shoes!

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Courtney tenses.

COURTNEY

We got another problem.

TED

TED

Only three problems at a time!

Madly scampers, looking unlikely to reach the hatch in time.

THE NACELLE

takes sudden tilt forward. Ted's feet slide out from under
him sending him on a mad slide toward the front.

TED (CONT'D)

Not again!

As the front of the nacelle slips under the water, the

HATCH

Slams shut.

TED

Slides into the water as the

NACELLE

Disappears.

END ACT I

ACT II

EXT. OCEAN

Boils where the nacelle submerged.

The great swells pass, the sea settles but for a little froth, then

TED

Pops his head out of the calming froth.

TED (CONT'D)
(looks around)
What the...

He rises from the bubbles, standing knee deep, several jerks make him unstable.

He turns toward the front, annoyed.

TED (CONT'D)
You gotta be --

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Courtney watches the screen.

COURTNEY
Ted. You dead?

Nothing.

COURTNEY (CONT'D)
I can't do this alone.

TED (V.O.)
(annoyed)
I'm here.

COURTNEY
Uncle Ted!

SCRAPING and a few jolts as she continues to navigate the ship.

EXT. UNDERWATER

The trench where the hull drags bottom, pounds into the side with a SCRAPE. It bounces off and into the other side knocking

TED

Off his feet.

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

A hard jolt nearly knocks Courtney out of her chair.

COURTNEY
Shit! Computer, little help!

THE DOCTOR
Shut down thrusters.

EXT. HULL

It slides into position, slashing into the mud and sliding as the walls of the trench begin caving in around it.

TED

Still frustrated, gets back to his feet, still knee-deep in sloshing swells.

COURTNEY (V.O.)
Are you okay?

TED
(sinking)
A little wet and cold, but yeah.

COURTNEY

Rejoices.

COURTNEY
You crazy courageous son of a bitch!

TED (V.O.)
I do feel like a bug on a windshield.

COURTNEY
Where are you?

TED

Casts a scrutinizing gaze forward.

ENTERPRISE

The black saucer is still exposed.

TED

Puzzles, still sinking, now to his waist.

TED
We're still --

He notices the rising water.

TED (CONT'D)
Oh, exposed a little.

COURTNEY

She checks her monitor.

COURTNEY
Four hundred thousand metric tons
sitting on wed mud and sand? Give
it a minute.

TED

TED
I think I see what you mean.

Now up over his waist, then quickly to his neck as he starts swimming for the saucer.

He paddles a short distance to the exposed edge of the saucer as it sinks level to the top surface.

COURTNEY

Still scanning, puzzles.

COURTNEY
What's all that sloshing?

TED (V.O.)
(sloshy sounding)
I decided to take a dip.

COURTNEY
In the ocean?

TED (V.O.)
(sloshy sounding)
I'm freezin' my ass off but, yeah.

TED

Drags himself up the back of the saucer and hits the ground running to keep ahead of the advancing water.

COURTNEY

Scans and pounds her phone keyboard.

COURTNEY
How are you getting in?

TED

Stands by the dome, looking up at the towering flag.

TED
Taking a shortcut.

COURTNEY

Puzzles.

COURTNEY
The Klingons are coming this way!

TED (V.O.)
We need to cloak our life signs.

COURTNEY
What?

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

The forward screen parts in half, exposing a panoramic window with a divide in the middle.

COURTNEY
So that's what the world looks like!

Ted approaches as the window parts.

TED
(dripping wet)
Bet ya didn't know this was here.

COURTNEY
Holy crap! Too cool!

Ted enters, leaving a wet trail. The glass doors close just as water reaches and rises on the glass.

TED
Computer, activate a dampening field to cloak our life signs.

COMPUTER
Acknowledged.

TED

If they cant see us, maybe they'll just think it's some floating hot dog stand or pirate ship. Really?! Pirates?

THE DOCTOR

Good idea.

COURTNEY

Ya said ya wouldn't get mad.

TED

I didn't say make us the Black Pearl.

COURTNEY

Gotta admit, it's bad ass.

THE DOCTOR

I'd have to concur.

TED

Nobody's ever on my side.

KLINGON SCREEN

Shows only the the base of the pole out of the water with flag rustling in the breeze.

KLINGON HELMSMAN

What is that?

KLINGON CAPTAIN

Puzzles over the sight.

BARAK SUL

What am I looking at?

DOCTOR MCKINNEY (O.S.)

Pirates.

BARAK SUL

(agressively)

Who are you?

DOCTOR MCKINNEY

(very nervous)

We have been cleaning the transwarp coils.

BARAK SUL

You are not connected to our collective.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY

(anxiously searching for a story)

The neural transceiver is malfunctioning! It is being repaired.

Barak comes face to face with McKinney, who sweats like a pig.

BARAK SUL

(skeptical)

What is pirates?

DOCTOR MCKINNEY

Ocean going marauders. They are not a threat.

KLINGON HELMSMAN

It floats under the surface?

BARAK SUL

(to Klingon 2)

How many crew members?

KLINGON 3

I see no life signs now.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY

They have a very small crew if any at all.

BARAK SUL

We scanned life signs.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY

They have the ability to cast false life signs, to make it look like a bigger force. I can go down and take care of them.

KLINGON CAPTAIN

(motions to Klingon 3)

Take this one with you. Assimilate whoever you find for our force. If you find Bundy, kill him.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY

I can do this alone. You'll need your bridge crew for the battle.

BARAK SUL
(long pause, sits)
Very well.
(to transporter)
Beam him to the craft.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY
(stunned)
Huh?

He beams to the

EXT. ENTERPRISE - DAY

He beams to just above the bridge window.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY
(distraught)
Ah!

He takes a moment to adjust.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY (CONT'D)
(delirious)
Oh, yes! I freakin' beamed! I'm
gonna pass out!

He urgently clings to the flag pole, ankle deep in sea and swells.

MCKINNEY

Stands by the pole like he were standing on water.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY (CONT'D)
I'm screwed!

INT. KLINGON BRIDGE

Klingon 3 alerts.

KLINGON 3
I have located Kirk!

BARAK SUL
Like you located Bundy?!

KLINGON 3
Here, he is on shore.

BARAK SUL
Alter course! Charge weapons!

Nose to nose with Klingon 3.

KLINGON 3

If you are wrong!

Klingon 3 submits.

EXT. KLINGON BIRD OF PREY

Darts toward the Alaskan shoreline.

INT. FLOOR B-2 - DAY

The group scramble down a hallway, GROWLING and the POUNDING OF CLAWED FEET following closely.

They find an open door and pile in.

Jimmy slams the door as it's whacked by a GROWLING beast. They continue to SCRATCH and GROWL as the group pants and laments.

MIDGE

I never thought I could run that fast.

TAMMY

I can't.

JIMMY

As long as they don't figure out how to turn the doorknob, we're fine.

The RATTLE OF THE DOORKNOB is evident.

TAMMY

You really had to say it.

She dashes to the door as it releases.

A claw comes through, barely missing her.

Jimmy and Midge come to the rescue, flinging themselves against the door as the beast SCREAMS in pain and pulls the paw out.

JIMMY

No lock, great.

He latches the door as they rattle the knob. The girls prop against the door.

TAMMY

Now what?

They search around, but the room offers no help.

COMMANDER MALONE (V.O.)
Nothing will help you now.

TAMMY
I really hate you.

JIMMY
What are you gonna do with us now?

COMMANDER MALONE (V.O.)
You got so much farther than I
thought you would. Oh, the guards
don't exist. The targs are all I
needed.

JIMMY
For what?

COMMANDER MALONE
To tease you, to find a way to
gently coax the information I know
you are keeping from me, and to
show you that resistance, in fact,
is futile.

TAMMY
I assure you, if you're involved
with --

COMMANDER MALONE
I got secrets, too and they're
going to enable this world to
advance far beyond our wildest
dreams! Those little Klingon Borgs
gave me that idea.

TAMMY
Holy shit.

JIMMY
You bastard. You're on of them.

COMMANDER MALONE
One of what? I control them.

TAMMY
No you don't!

COMMANDER MALONE
I activated them. Let them know
who was boss, and put them back to
sleep.

(MORE)

COMMANDER MALONE (CONT'D)

Then, I reactivated them in order to force your hand to reveal your ship. Now I know what it is, and where it is.

JIMMY

We don't even know if it's really down there.

COMMANDER MALONE

Oh, you'll be pleased to know, my dear wife's boyfriend and her, daughter just passed us in that little secret you're keeping! This is better than I ever dreamed. Now I don't need you any, more.

TAMMY

(looks at Midge)
Not my friggin' boyfriend.

COMMANDER MALONE

Unfortunately for you, your ship has a thermonuclear device stuck to it's ass that someone...

(a little fake dramatic)
decided to arm against my wishes, so any hope you've got will go up in smoke in seventeen minutes give or take a few painful seconds and this could have all been prevented if you had told me what I needed to know.

MIDGE

I don't like him at all.

TAMMY

(to Malone)
Why?

COMMANDER MALONE

I didn't want this but you sat on a weapon essential to the defense of this planet. I have the upmost confidence that your resourceful boyfriend will figure out how to completely screw up, creating the castastrophic event that will begin the evolution of human culture.

TAMMY

Not my friggin' --

COMMANDER MALONE

Of course, I wont be anywhere near here but close enough to come to the rescue with helping hands that will miraculously heal the injured and dying with a single injection of Borg nanoprobes, and of course, you're team will be blamed for the destruction.

MIDGE

I gonna hurt him.

JIMMY

(to Malone)

The Borg have their own agenda and you are irrelevant.

COMMANDER MALONE

We got the fire power and know how to take them down.

JIMMY

It's gonna take more than fire power! They're time travellers trying to change their own timeline.

Nothing.

TAMMY

Jack. You there?

They puzzle.

EXT. CUTTER

TAMMY (V.O.)

Jack.

Malone stares intently at

JESSICA

Smiling with an evil glow.

COMMANDER MALONE (V.O.)

Who the hell are you and what are you doing on my ship!?

END ACT II

ACT III

INT. ENTERPRISE ENGINEERING

Ted watches the box as it feeds the reactor.

TED
(tap badge)
How are the power levels?

Ted departs it for another panel and works.

COURTNEY (V.O.)
Fifty two percent.

TED
Barely enough for transporters.
Computer, power isn't being
distributed efficiently. Status of
drive plasma.

COMPUTER
Levels are at thirty percent due to
deterioration of plasma conduits.
Several pinpoint leaks throughout
the system --

TED
Now I know. Can we achieve warp
drive?

COMPUTER
Warp plasma is adequate for up to
warp six.

TED
Impulse engines?

COMPUTER
Sixty per cent and improving.

TED
Status of the Klingon ship.

COMPUTER
Klingon ship is operating at forty
seven per cent efficiency in power,
sixty three percent weapons and has
assumed a heading toward James
Kirk's life sign.

TED
(scrambling for answers)
We need some help. Open a channel
to Ensign Shelley Dublain.

INT. SHELLEY'S HOUSE

An old two-story Victorian painted purple on a quiet street with two kids, Tammy, 6, a slender, wiry little blonde girl and Teddy, 9, a nerdy, dark haired kid with black horn-rimmed glasses.

The window opens.

Out of it leans SHELLEY DUBLAIN, 39, dishwater blonde, pretty, and diminutive, and in a hurry.

SHELLEY
Teddy, Tammy! How would you like
to go with mommy on a little ride
to the storage unit?

TEDDY
We have a storage unit?

SHELLEY
With a top secret video game I've
been working on!

KIDS
(dashing off)
Yeah!

THE KIDS

run to the car, SCREAMING.

SHELLEY (V.O.)
(she watches her kids)
This had better be good, Ted!

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Courtney urgently punches her iPhone.

COURTNEY
I think I got it!

THE DOCTOR
What?

COURTNEY

I can reroute some functions directly through my iPhone to avoid the virus's effects but that means we won't be able to use the bridge controls for some stuff.

THE DOCTOR

Very good. I'm seeing improvement in our plasma levels. I opened the Brussard collectors and we're getting a decent photon count from the atmosphere. Not great, but it's something.

COURTNEY

I got an idea how to get us there without the Klingons seeing us.

She scurries to the lift just as

TED

Appears in the lift.

TED

Where you going? We gotta move.

COURTNEY

I'm heading to the transporter room so give me a few minutes and when I give you the word, move us forward.

The doors close.

INT. LIFT

Courtney still works the iPhone.

COURTNEY

Computer, tell me everything about that transporter tech stuff.

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Ted heads for the chair.

TED

Status.

THE DOCTOR

The Klingons are nearing the location where our people are being held.

TED
They're slow.

THE DOCTOR
They seem to be having intermittent malfunctions with their propulsion systems.

EXT. KLINGON SHIP

Barely moving.

INT. KLINGON BRIDGE

Barak Sul leans forward.

BARAK SUL
What is the trouble!

KLINGON 3
We have been sabotaged.

KLINGON 3

Digging in a panel, pulling out a burned relay.

KLINGON 3 (CONT'D)
And I know who.

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Ted laments.

COURTNEY
We're buried in mud and sand, but I got an idea.

TED
(pragmatic)
Damn it. We still can't navigate or fly and we're half buried. Sounds pretty hopeless.

THE DOCTOR
Has that ever stopped you before?

TED
Just makes me wanna turn the page to see what happens.

THE DOCTOR
You remind me of Tom Paris.

TED

I reconstituted the dilithium crystals and cold started the warp core. All we need is power and way to steer this beast, and shovels.

INT. CORRIDOR

Courtney, running flat out, dashes through the doors of the TRANSPORTER ROOM

And joins her phone with the console.

COURTNEY

Come on, baby. Play nice and talk.

THE CONSOLE

Lights up with the phone.

KLINGON SHIP

Starts moving faster, resuming their quest for the small mountain near the shoreline.

INT. KLINGON BRIDGE

Sul leans back in his seat.

BARAK SUL

Where is he?

KLINGON 3

There!

SCREEN

A mountainside and long escarpment to the ocean with a bunker-like projection at the top of the cliff.

BARAK SUL

Lock weapons and fire!

THE KLINGON SHIP

Fires a disruptor blast destroying the bunker, then another tearing a hole in the hill.

INT. FLOOR B-2

The room is jarred by the blast.

TAMMY
Somebody's shooting at us!

JIMMY
But we're in a basement.

MIDGE
Shooting?

TAMMY
That was a Klingon disruptor.

JIMMY
You know that?

TAMMY
It has a particular --
Another jolt as pieces of the ceiling come down.

JIMMY
We gotta get out'ta here.

Another blast tears out a six-foot piece of the wall,
exposing them to the outside.

They pick themselves off the floor. The air is choked with
dust and smoke.

MIDGE
(looking out)
We're not in a basement.

Jimmy heads for the break and looks out, then down to

THE OCEAN

Crashing waves at the bottom of the rocky cliff.

JIMMY

Turns, disappointed.

JIMMY
Not that way.

MIDGE
(points to the door)
Then I'm goin' this way.

Tammy rushes to the door, looks through the small window.

TAMMY
I don't see anything out there.

MIDGE
They'll be somewhere.

JIMMY
Go, now.

They cautiously traipse out into the very long
HALLWAY

Leaving the door open, then hustle toward a blind turn.

MIDGE
I don't smell 'em around.

TAMMY
We seem to have a blood hound with
us.

JIMMY
That might be an advantage.

They come to a juncture.

MIDGE
(heads to the right)
Come on. My nose says this way.

Another jarring rumble bring down lights and ceiling tiles.

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Courtney works the console, frowns, puzzles.

COURTNEY
What the hell.

She feverishly continues.

COURTNEY (CONT'D)
(smiles defiantly)
I got a guinea pig!

She punches console and looks to the transporter pad.

The image fails to completely materialize.

COURTNEY (CONT'D)
(pounding on the console.)
Oh no you don't!

She grits her teeth, works the console, looks up and, nods approvingly.

COURTNEY (CONT'D)
Hello, cutie.

She spies her phone and punches buttons.

INT. KLINGON BRIDGE

Sul salivates.

BARAK SUL
Did we kill them?

KLINGON 3
Life signs are fading.

BARAK SUL
How many photon torpedoes?

KLINGON 3
One.

BARAK SUL
(annoyed)
Keep firing disruptors until life
signs are gone!

THE KLINGON SHIP

Fires lower at the mountain.

INT. HALLWAY

The group sprints down the hall, rounds the corner.

A SCREAM, then

They scramble back around the corner, only a couple seconds
ahead of TWO TARGS, sliding and tumbling around the corner.

The group dashes as a phone RINGS.

JIMMY
Who's ringing now?

MIDGE
My phone's still on the boat.

TAMMY
(she pulls her phone,
looks)
Oh crap.

She answers, still running, stunned.

TAMMY (CONT'D)
(stops, distracted)
Courtney?

COURTNEY

Stands at the console, frightened.

COURTNEY
You gotta jump!

TAMMY
What?

COURTNEY
You gotta jump now!

TAMMY
Where?

COURTNEY
The big hole!

TED

Leans forward in the chair.

TED
Tammy, where's Jimmy?

She runs to catch up.

TAMMY
He's here.

TED (V.O.)
The Klingons are trying to kill you
but we don't have a transporter
lock --

TAMMY
We're in a hallway, close to the
room with the big hole.

JIMMY
(looks back)
Who is it?

TAMMY
Ted wants us to jump out the hole --

JIMMY
There's the door. Move!

MIDGE

Do you know what you're saying!?

JIMMY

He knows what he's doing!

Jimmy stops at the door, the girls slow.

TAMMY

Famous last words!

TED

Shakes his head.

TED

I heard that.

TAMMY

Entering the room.

TAMMY

Noooooooooo!

JIMMY

Go! Jump!

INT. CONFERENCE ROOM

Tammy runs toward the hole, closes her eyes. Midge follows close, then Jimmy as Targs crash in the doorway, SNARLING AND GROWLING.

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

The doctor alerts.

THE DOCTOR

The Klingons are coming around the mountain!

TED

Christ! Courtney, now!

CONFERENCE ROOM

Tammy jumps out. Midge, just behind, hesitates, but Jimmy tackles her with a SCREAM just short of the hole and their momentum carries them out of the

EXT. HOLE

SCREAMING all the way.

INT. KLINGON BRIDGE

They see on the

SCREEN

The falling bodies.

BARAK SUL

There they are! Fire!

THE KLINGON SHIP

Moves into position but the

BODIES

Begin the transport swirl as the ship fires into the mountainside.

BELOW

the sea turns to complete chaos, rising, rising, washing away revealing

ENTERPRISE

Erupting from the chaos, rising, creating a monstrous storm of falling water, dwarfing the Klingon ship.

ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Five forms materialize on the upper level.

Jimmy on the floor with Midge, Tammy, eyes closed, Courtney and McKinney.

MCKINNEY

(excited)

I'm dead and in trekkie heaven!

Midge lays on the floor, with Jimmy on top.

MIDGE

Uh, uh.

JIMMY

We're safe.

MIDGE

Uh.

She and Jimmy rise awkwardly, but their eyes are caught by

TAMMY

Opens her eyes. Her hair has swept back, showing pointed ears and slanting eyebrows and greenish skin.

MIDGE (CONT'D)

Tam, hun. What on god's green Earth happened to you?

TAMMY

Oh, my.

She covers her ears with her hair, stands, sees Ted, staring at her.

TAMMY (CONT'D)

You've never seen a Vulcan before?

TED

I knew it, but we don't have time to rejoice for Tammy coming out of the closet.

(to Tammy)

I need you at the helm! Get us out'ta here! Jimmy tactical. Court how are we --

A jolt.

JIMMY

Shields are up, now.

COURTNEY

We now have full function, for awhile.

TED

Do not return fire! Get us out of here! Stay on the deck and head for that storm, fast as we can go.

THE SHIPS

Face each other. Klingons fire disruptors, deflected by the shields.

Enterprise backs, turns, and makes a beeline for the open ocean followed by the firing Klingon ship.

ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Everyone has a station.

TED (CONT'D)

We don't wanna make any more of a spectacle than we already are.

JIMMY

When can we return fire?

TED

We need to get far away from the shore. Shields?

JIMMY

Eighty per cent.

TED

Do we have the power to get into orbit?

COURTNEY

(punching iPhone buttons)

I'm still working on my reroutes, but we will.

MIDGE

You guys gotta tell me what's goin' on!

A jolt.

TED

Later. Doc, she's with you.

THE DOCTOR

(to Midge)

Hopefully, I won't need you.

MIDGE

Thanks a lot.

TED

Weapons?

JIMMY

Phasers are still off line but we have thirty one transphasic torpedoes, and one alpha-omega.

TED

That one I'm saving for a Borg I know. Let's keep running.

EXT. OCEAN - DAY

The boys bale water from their swamped, broken boat.

BANNER

Can't say this is the best day of my life.

BARKLEY

Hope your little government surveillance boys saw us get rolled.

BANNER

They're comin' now, but they wont care.

BARKLEY

Well, been a nice life.

BANNER

They could'a left us with one last fatty.

They alert, look to the shoreline to see

ENTERPRISE

being chased by the Klingon ship at incredibly high speed, close to the water. The Klingons fire several disruptor blasts at the ship as they blow past the

FISHING BOAT

The boys go glassy-eyed.

BARKLEY

Did you see that?

BANNER

Told ya they didn't care.

BARKLEY

Hope they choke on our fishing rods.

BANNER

We gotta get more'a that pot, man.

Suddenly, a large shadow, covers the boat.

They look up with blank stares.

Beaming swirls start, as they let out a SCREAM and disappear.

EXT. SKIES

A squad of fighter jets cut through the air in the opposite direction.

ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Jimmy alerts.

JIMMY

Ted, I got twenty bogies dead ahead at three thousand feet, and closing fast.

TED

We got forward shields?

JIMMY

Sixty per cent.

TED

Looks like we're gonna scare the hell of of 'em. Stay low.

EXT. JET FIGHTER

The pilot squints as he stares down the target, then goes wide-eyed.

PILOT

I got, I don't know what I got, but it's big and two hundred feet off the deck, but it's two thousand off the deck, too.

PILOT 2 (V.O.)

It's massive!

PILOT

Evasive action!

THE ENTERPRISE

Rifles along the water, still followed by the Klingons firing as the squadron flies over them in scattered chaos.

The force of the wind scatters the jets everywhere as another craft settles in behind the Klingons. The

DELTA FLYER

Bears down on the Klingons.

INT. DELTA FLYER

Shelley pilots with an attitude.

Teddy sits at tactical itching to fire.

Tammy sits, gritting her teeth with her hands raised.

SHELLEY
Ready Teddy?!

TEDDY
Weapons charged!

SHELLEY
We gonna kick your Klingon asses!
Fire at will!

LITTLE TAMMY
Who's Will?

TEDDY
(grabbing joystick)
Die sucka's!

Teddy's screen

Shows phaser blasts tearing away at the aft section.

SHELLEY

Grits her teeth.

SHELLEY
Come on, Teddy! Kill those mutha
bastards!

LITTLE TAMMY
Mommy's using potty mouth again!

TEDDY
She's gone insane!

SHELLEY
Daddy never hears about this.

LITTLE TAMMY
Best video game ever!

KLINGON BRIDGE

A jolt and sparks fly.

BARAK SUL
What was that?!

KLINGON HELMSMAN
We're being fired upon by another
ship!

BARAK SUL
Return fire!

THE KLINGONS

Veer off followed by the Flyer, firing back.

SHELLEY

Is jolted causing HYSTERICAL LAUGHING from the kids.

SHELLEY
(stuggling with controls)
My kids are in here you son of a
bitch! Kill the bastards!

TEDDY
(watches the monitor)
Stop moving all over!

THE FLYER

Moves from side to side.

SHELLEY

Struggles with controls.

SHELLEY
Those donkey butts got my
stabilizers! You gotta deal with
it!

LITTLE TAMMY
(giggling uncontrollably)
Mommy's lost her marbles!

ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Courtney alerts.

COURTNEY
The Klingons veered off.

TAMMY
Somebody's got the Delta Flyer?

TED
Had to bring out some
reinforcements.

TAMMY
Shelley?

TED
Maybe.

INT. DELTA FLYER

The kids are totally into it.

TEDDY
They raised their shields!

SHELLEY
We probably did all we can do for
now. Let's freak 'em out.

THE FLYER

Buzzes the Klingons who miss with their return fire.

The flyer takes another pass, fires phasers at point blank causing the bird to vent plasma, and then makes a wavy line toward the Enterprise.

INT. DELTA FLYER

The kids are ecstatic.

TEDDY
(still hands in the air)
I can even feel us moving like a
roller coaster!

LITTLE TAMMY
(pressed into her seat)
I can't move.

SHELLEY
Oops. Computer, activate inertial
dampeners.

LITTLE TAMMY
(worn out still giggling)
Better.

TEDDY
Where did you get this game? Can
we keep it!?

LITTLE TAMMY

Please oh please oh --

SHELLEY

The company only gave it to me for a short time to evaluate, so it's our little secret until it hits the market, but yeah, we're keeping it.

TEDDY

Totally awesome!

LITTLE TAMMY

(watching monitor)

And I can watch Sponge Bob Square Pants whenever I want this show where big people are wrestling naked.

SHELLEY

Gotta love that babysitting function, what?

Little Tammy watches the

MONITOR

Showing a porn movie.

LITTLE TAMMY

SHELLEY (O.S.) (CONT'D)

Shut that off.

Looks to her mother like there's a big secret.

LITTLE TAMMY

(whispers)

Does Daddy know?

SHELLEY (V.O.)

Definitely not Daddy. He'll hog the game so no Daddy, especially the wrestlers, now shut it off or turn it back to Sponge Dude.

She takes a swipe or two on the screen, back to Sponge Bob.

THE DELTA FLYER

Buzzes toward Enterprise.

INT. DELTA FLYER

In the transporter, the boys stand, blankly. Banner touches a force field and jumps back.

BANNER

Told ya. Government's got us now.

BARKLEY

Maybe they can tell us where our stash is.

BANNER

Ya think they got any Funyuns around here?

SHELLEY (O.S.)

No, no Funyuns!

Barkley looks at him in disgust while

ENTERPRISE

And the Delta Flyer blast past the

CUTTER

Distracting Jessica during the assimilation process on Malone.

She watches from the 01 deck with several of the assimilated crew members in various parts of the ship, watching.

JESSICA

Another player.

She stares off into space for a moment.

COMMANDER MALONE

What do we do now?

JESSICA

Our fleet is arriving as we speak.
Their destruction, is at hand.

EXT. JUPITER

Moving around and past the planet, a quantum singularity forms. A cloud with a vortex of many colors. The vortex intensifies, turns to a bright amber, then much more defined, as out comes

A CUBE

Then another, and another, several more and three spheres, then a different color sphere, much more ornate and statley as other cubes continue to pile out.

INT. QUEEN'S ABODE - DAY

The QUEEN, another Borg hybrid with only a couple external implants, watches a

MONITOR

Showing the Klingon bridge.

QUEEN (O.S.)

I decided to come to the Alpha
Quadrant to observe your progress.

The Klingons are startled.

BARAK SUL

(looking into monitor)
We can do what was asked of us.

QUEEN

I needed to be here, to make sure
our mission will be completed
satisfactorily.

BARAK SUL

And it will be.

The picture goes off.

QUEEN

Those Klingons are so impatient and
disrespectful.

The Queen is annoyed.

QUEEN (CONT'D)

(to a drone)

I am questioning our experiment
with these lower forms. We will
wait here for now, but at first
sign of failure, we must take Earth
our way.

A SERVANT DRONE

Who resembles the normal crew of his type, acknowledges.

DRONE

I will initiate preparations.

The queen focused and arrogant, ponders.

INT. ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Midge checks communications console.

MIDGE

I think somebody's callin' us.

TED

Take us up into the cloud. Open a channel. Hey Shelley!

SHELLEY (V.O.)

Hello again. I thought we were done with this hologram Trekkie crap.

TED

Courtney found it and it's not a hologram.

SHELLEY

Tammy's little girl?

TAMMY

She's not little anymore.

ENTERPRISE

And Delta flyer take an abrupt jump upward and pound into the storm clouds followed by the Klingons who dart up and over.

ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Ted jumps out of the chair.

TED

Jimmy, you've got the Con. Don't break my ship.

JIMMY

Yes Captain.

TED

You know the plan.

JIMMY

(sits in the chair)
Got it.

TAMMY

Where are you going?

TED

(enters lift)

Battle bridge.

The doors close.

INT. LIFT

Ted takes a deep breath.

TED

Shelley.

SHELLEY (V.O.)

Yes.

TED

Take the ship into shuttle bay.

SHELLEY

Come on. I got the kids.

TED

You brought --

SHELLEY

Try getting a babysitter at short notice.

TED

Bring it in anyway.

SHELLEY

So this is the big invasion.

TED

This is just the beginning.

SHELLEY

I'm coming in, but I'm not staying for the fun.

TED

Don't expect ya to.

INT. DELTA FLYER

The kids look bored.

TEDDY

Who was that you were talking to?

SHELLEY

Online chat. You're going to find out a lot of things, but right now, hit the green button and play the simulation game for a little while Mommy takes care a some errands.

TEDDY

More? Sweet!

SHELLEY

(to Little Tammy)
Sweet Cheeks. How you doing? Not watching the wrestlers.

LITTLE TAMMY

(watching T.V.)
I'm bingeing on Bob.

SHELLEY

All systems go.

THROUGH THE WINDSHIELD

They enter the cloud.

Her steering is taken over.

COMPUTER

Control of the ship has been transferred.

Shelley relaxes.

THE KLINGON SHIP

Flies over the clouds.

INT. KLINGON BRIDGE

Sul searches the cloud tops on the screen.

BARAK SUL

They are here!

KLINGON 3

Electromagnetic interference has rendered our scanners useless.

BARAK SUL

We will use our eyes.

He watches the

SCREEN

As miles of clouds lie ahead.

ENTERPRISE BRIDGE

Jimmy sits in the chair with McKinney at his left.

JIMMY

It's good to see your not dead.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY

I was trapped in a stasis pod for six months till the power went out.

JIMMY

Not gonna ask.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY

I did find out about how they do things. When I got out, they thought I was just one of the other drones who had a malfunctioning neural transceiver.

JIMMY

So they are all Borg.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY

I guess so. They act like Klingons, just as nasty as Klingons, and just as they smell like they've been dead for three weeks.

JIMMY

Sounds like a Klingon to me.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY

What I did find out is their first goal is to kill you.

JIMMY

Why me?

DOCTOR MCKINNEY

I was able to hack into the ship's logs.

He gets excited, wipes the sweat off his forehead.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY (CONT'D)
Seems that they travelled back in time by mistake and appeared four hundred years ago. They crash landed in the arctic and went into stasis until the actual invasion was scheduled. They were activated by --

TAMMY
My dear husband.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY
He's your's?

TAMMY
For now.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY
They were able to send a distress call and were instructed to go into stasis until the Commander came to bring them out.

McKinney starts to back away from Jimmy.

JIMMY
I wasn't part of his plan.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY
He thinks he's got a spacecraft that's strong enough to take over the world.

JIMMY
And he's dealing with, ah, somebody. Why can't I remember?

DOCTOR MCKINNEY
Her name is Jessica. The file said she was a race of people who is forgotten hours after they depart.

TAMMY
It's a defense mechanism.

JIMMY
I remember a fight and lots of blood, but I can't remember who with.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY

Uh, uh. She's alive and kicking.
She's the time traveller that's
coordinating the entire invasion.

JIMMY

You didn't say anything about an
invasion.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY

I am now.

MIDGE

Let's just take these alien
bastards on and blow the crap out
of 'em then.

JIMMY

First, we gotta deal with these
Klingons.

DOCTOR MCKINNEY

I got a lot of colleagues in that
ship.

JIMMY

Not any more. Take us up to the
top of the cloud and let our
friends get a little peek.
Courtney, activate that pirate flag
again. I want to show 'em what
they missed, and shields down.

TAMMY

You're asking for it.

JIMMY

Yup, but I have a feeling.

A small jolt.

TAMMY

What was that?

KLINGON SHIP

Hovers over the clouds.
